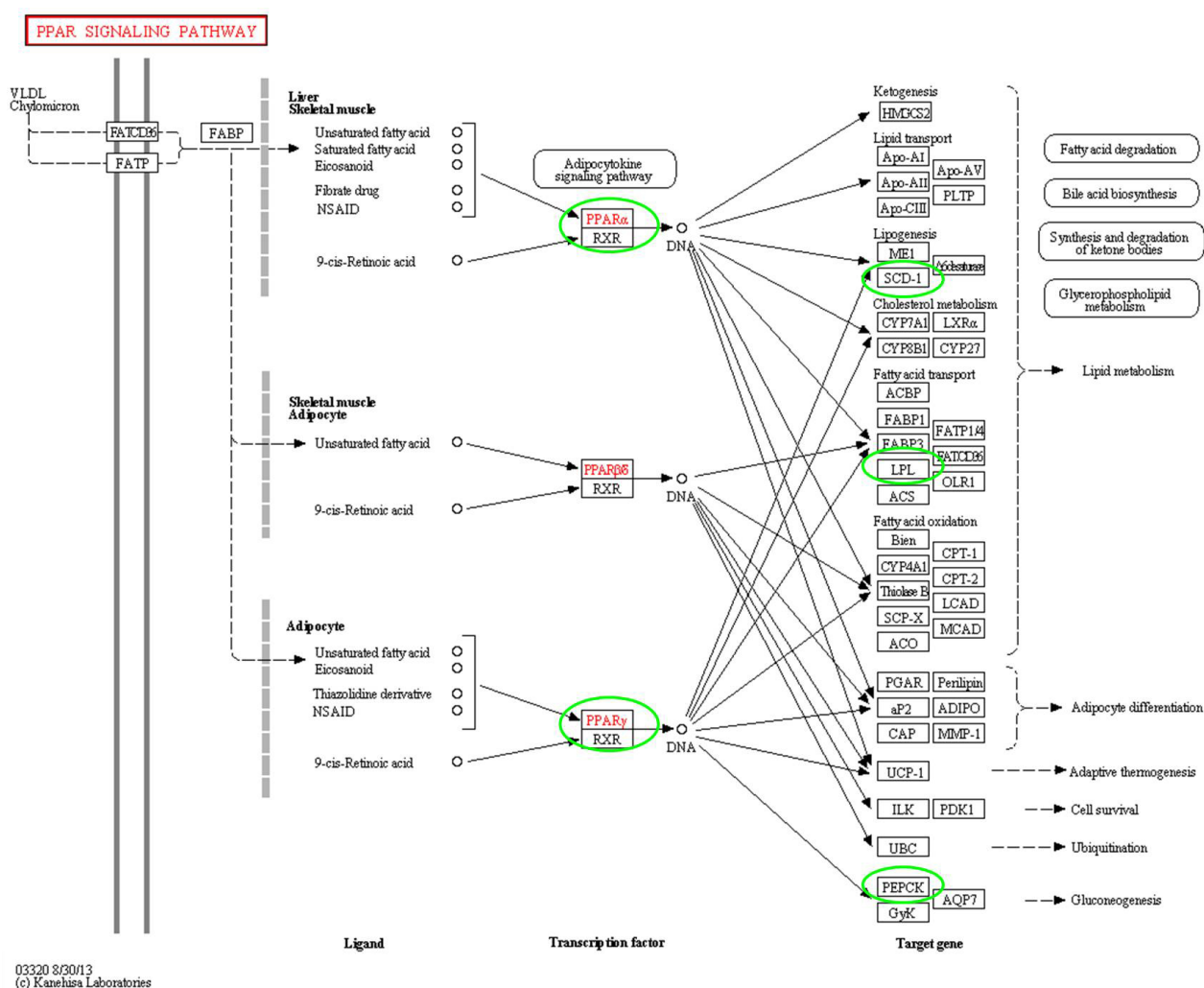


Figure S1. Map of the PPAR signalling pathway (KEGG PATHWAY database, map03320). Five candidate genes in our study are highlighted in ovals
